### **REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**

**Monday, January 27, 2020**

**7:00 P.M.**

Lodi Village Council met on the above date for a Regular Meeting with the following Council Members present: Miller, Mapes, May, Graham, Ridenour, and Jameyson. Also in attendance were Utility/Street Superintendent Tracy Haltrich, Fire Chief Chris Ridenour, and Police Lieutenant Brian Ritchie. Mayor Robert Geissman, Clerk-Treasurer Annette Geissman, and Village Solicitor Irving Sugerma were absent.

Karen Glass, representing LHEDO, was present and gave an overview of the downtown business survey results prepared by the LHEDO group.

#### **LEGISLATION**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, TRANSFERRING ITEMS BETWEEN FUNDS AND/OR INCREASING, DECREASING, OR TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATION ITEMS WITHIN FUNDS. A motion was made by Jameyson and seconded by Miller to pass the ordinance. It was determined that the police capital outlay request will be increased from \$40,000 to \$41,500.
