

## **Notice of Public Hearing #1**

Posting Date: June 7, 2020

The Village of Lodi intends to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding under the Residential Public Infrastructure Grant (RPIG) Program. Community Development Block Grants are federally-funded grants administered by the state. The Village is eligible for up to \$750,000 in RPIG funding, providing the Village meets applicable requirements.

The first of two public hearings will be held Wednesday, June 17, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. via Zoom during the Village of Lodi Planning and Zoning Commission Meeting. Participants may also request to speak during the public hearing portion of the meeting. The public hearing will be held to provide citizens with pertinent information about Community Development Block Grants including an explanation of eligible activities and program requirements. Community Development Block Grants can fund a broad range of activities, including: economic development projects, streets, water supply, drainage, and sanitary sewer improvements, park acquisition and improvements, demolition of unsafe structures, rehabilitation of housing, and neighborhood facilities. The activities must be designed to primarily benefit low- and moderate- income persons, aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight, or meet an urgent need of the community.
