PROCESS FOR FILING A COMPLAINT REGARDING AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LODI POLICE DEPARTMENT

Complaints against employees of the Lodi Police Department may be made by choosing one of the following.

1. Complaints may be made using the "Personnel Complaint" form which is posted on the Village of Lodi web page. Complaint forms may also be obtained in the lobby of the police department, or the lobby of the utility's office.
2. Complaints can be made verbally to any officer, supervisor, or the Chief of Police.

All complaints will be reviewed by the Chief of Police and will then be assigned for investigation by a supervisor.

The complainant will be kept fully up to date on the process and will be notified once a determination has been made.

Lodi Police Department Policy dictates the investigation shall be concluded within 60 days of its assignment for investigation. Typically, all complaints are completed within a 14-day period.

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
