**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS FOR THE VILLAGE OF LODI, OHIO, AMENDING
SECTION 6 OF RESOLUTION NO. 35-18 CONCERNING THE ASSESSMENT OF WATER CHARGES TO
OWNERS OF TRAILER PARKS**

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Board of Public Affairs for the Village of Lodi, Ohio (the "BPA") is authorized by statute to create and modify bylaws for the assessment of public utilities, including waterworks, as necessary for the safe, economical, and efficient management of such utilities pursuant to R.C. 735.29;

WHEREAS, the BPA has deemed it necessary to amend Section 6 "Multiple Occupancy" of Resolution No. 35-18 to allow for the efficient management and collection of assessments and charges for water services to mobile homes and/or trailer parks located within the Village's municipal limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Trustees of the Board of Public Affairs of the Village of Lodi, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 6 of Resolution No. 35-18, shall be amended and replaced with the following:

6. **MULTIPLE OCCUPANCY** – Where more than one dwelling or commercial unit is served through one meter, the number of gallons in each block served by said meter and/or the minimum charge above shall be multiplied by the number of dwelling or commercial units served.

Where residential customers are tenants or residents of a trailer or mobile home park located within the Village's municipal limits, and are served through one master meter, the Village of Lodi will assess the total monthly water usage charges or assessments for all such tenants or residents directly to the owner of the trailer or mobile home park where such customers reside. In such an event, the payment of such billings for all persons served shall be the responsibility of the owner.

SECTION 2. That all other provisions of Resolution No. 35-18 shall not be amended by this Resolution, and this Resolution shall not modify any existing or previous ordinances or resolutions related to water charges, all of which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is deemed as a measure for the benefit of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Lodi and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the necessary votes required, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.


