Scheduled Mosquito Spraying

Village wide mosquito spraying began on May 21, 2024, and will continue every two weeks on Tuesday evenings throughout the summer season.

Five Year Trash Hauling Contract

The five-year trash hauling contract expired on April 30, 2024. The hauling service was bid out and the new bid amount is \$23 per month for the next five years for residential trash pick-up, effective May 1, 2024.

Notice for the Filling of Swimming Pools

Please be advised that the village can no longer accept manual water meter readings taken by residents when filling swimming pools. Electronic radio read meters have been installed in the village and any water meter readings will need to be taken electronically by a village water department employee. A reading needs to be taken before and after filling your swimming pool with water. The village water department will take all beginning pool readings on Tuesday mornings at approximately 10:00 a.m. and all ending readings on Thursday mornings at approximately 10:00 a.m. Please plan ahead to fill your pool between Tuesday and Thursday mornings. You must call village offices at 330-948-2040 by 2:00 p.m. on Monday to be put on the schedule for that particular week. Sewer credit is only available if proper meter readings are taken by a village employee and the total water usage for filling the pool is over 2,000 gallons. Manual readings from residents cannot be accepted.

FREE Paper Shredding Service

The village will not be holding an annual paper shredding event this year because free paper shredding services are available at the Medina County Recycling Center located at 8730 Lake Road, Seville, Ohio 44273, phone number 330-769-0289. This free service is available on Mondays and Wednesdays from 8 am to 4:30 pm, and on Saturdays from 7 am to 12 noon. We hope you take advantage of this free service.

Janice Street Rehabilitation Project Phase 1

Phase 1 of the Janice Street Rehabilitation Project is finished except for final touch up issues. A state OPWC Grant was received in the amount of \$249,950 to help fund this project.
